
# **Doctor Experiences With The German Spearhead In Russia**

Schenck's job was to treat the wounded and sick, but he soon realized that there was little he could do to save many of his patients. 



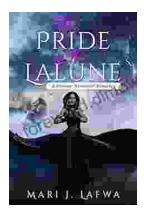
